The Advisory Board will partner with Recreation and Parks staff to prioritize projects to ensure that your gift will be used appropriately. *Friends of the Park* has established a Donor Advised Fund with the Truckee Tahoe Community Foundation (TTCF). Since incorporating in 1998, the Foundation has managed more than \$5 million for local organizations working to improve our community.
